



Escheat Notice

URGENT: PLEASE SIGN AND RETURN THIS NOTICE BACK TO US IN ORDER TO AVOID YOUR FUNDS BEING SENT TO THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA.

THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA REQUIRES US TO NOTIFY YOU THAT YOUR UNCLAIMED PROPERTY MAY BE TRANSFERRED TO THE STATE IF YOU DO NOT CONTACT US.

Dear Member:

California Unclaimed Property Law requires banks, banking and financial organizations to submit a report of all funds from deposit accounts, shares, or other interest to the State Controller’s Office (SCO) by October 4, 2024 and to transfer those funds no later than May 2, 2025 if the account has been inactive for three years.

According to our records, there has been no member activity on your account for more than two years. Therefore, your account is in danger of escheating to the state unless you respond by completing, signing, and returning this notice to us no later than May 2, 2025 or faxing it to (650) 508-7265, or visiting a Provident branch.

NOTE: If you hold term share certificates or IRAs with Provident that you have allowed to renew automatically and have had no other activity on other accounts, unfortunately your State still considers the account dormant.
